The following tables summarise Melbourne's extensive street tramway system – the largest system in the world. SG. All of the system is double track.

Operator: Keolis Downer EDI / Yarra Trams.

Summary of services:

To City: Mondays to Saturdays: approximately 500 until approximately 2330.

Sundays: approximately 730 to approximately 2300.

From City: Mondays to Saturdays: approximately 530 until approximately 2400 (**Friday and Saturday** nights until approximately 115).

Sundays: approximately 800 to approximately 2400.

Usual Frequencies: Mondays – Fridays: Peak frequent, Day 8 to 12 minutes, Evening 20 minutes.

Saturdays: Day 12 minutes, Evening 20 minutes.

Sundays: Early morning 30 minutes, Day 12 minutes, Evening 30 minutes.
