Specially equipped buses traverse Currie and Grenfell Streets, City in conventional mode before travelling in guided mode on the O-Bahn via Klemzig Station, Paradise Interchange and Tea Tree Plaza Interchange. Buses complete their trips in conventional mode on suburban roads.

Services operate frequently. Operator: Torrens Transit.
